DAY TRIPS

First Baptist Church Passion Play Thursday, April 13

First Baptist London began presenting The Passion Play in 1996. Since that time more than 50,000 people have attended the performances. The Passion Play depicts the events from the last week of Jesus' earthly ministry, including the crucifixion and resurrection. The play includes a cast of more than 150 people, including a choir of approximately 55 and a 35-piece orchestra.

Ashland: The Henry Clay Estate *and*Mary Todd Lincoln House Monday, May 8

The highlight of a visit to Ashland is the guided tour of the 18-room mansion. You will enter the front door and begin a journey through the Clay family mansion and time travel from the 18th century to the present. Tours of the mansion are guided by knowledgeable docents and begin on the hour and last approximately one hour.

The Mary Todd Lincoln House, located on West Main Street in downtown Lexington, Kentucky was the family home of the future wife of the 16th President. In 1977, the girlhood home opened to the public and became the first house museum in America to honor a First Lady.

Fort Boonesborough White Hall: Cassius Clay Estate

Thursday, Oct. 19

Fort Boonesborough was a frontier fort in Kentucky, founded by Daniel Boone and his men following their crossing of the Kentucky River on April 1, 1775. The settlement they founded, known as Boonesborough, Kentucky, is Kentucky's second oldest European-American settlement.

Historic white hall mansion, designed in Georgian and Italianate styles, boasts nearly ten thousand square feet with modern innovations of the time such as central heating and indoor plumbing.
