"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God".



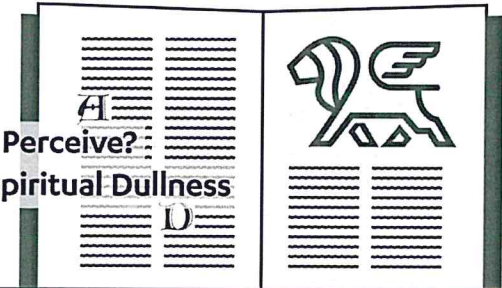
