Deacon of the Month— Tony Sosby

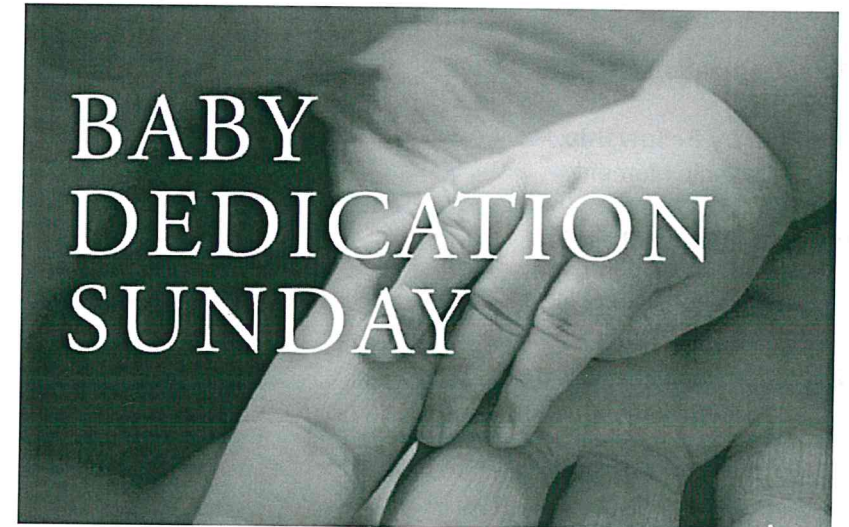
