You may have heard the story of a woman who in the rush of last-minute Christmas shopping, bought a box of fifty identical greeting cards. Without bothering to read what was written on the inside, she hastily signed and addressed all but one of them. Several days after they had been mailed, she came across the card that hadn't been sent. She looked at the message in the card and was appalled to read, "This card is just to say...a little gift is on the way!"

Over 700 years before Jesus was born in Bethlehem, God inspired the prophet Isaiah to proclaim, "For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; And the government shall be upon His shoulder, And His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6)

I believe this was God's way of saying to us, "This message is just to say...the gift of My Son is on the way." The gospel accounts remind us that this was no ordinary gift and no ordinary Son. An angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph and told him that Mary was pregnant and that they were to "call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins" (Matthew 1:21). Around the same time, the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and revealed that her Son "will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High" (Luke 1:32).

As we begin the Christmas season, let's keep in mind the true reason for why we celebrate. Let's not spend more time fretting over finding the perfect gift than we do celebrating God's grand demonstration of His love for us. Let's not busy ourselves to the point of exhaustion and neglect the moment in history when God stepped into our world and changed everything. Christmas is about Jesus. There's nothing wrong with gifts, parties, decorations, and

everything else that we experience in the month of December, but these are not what is most important—Jesus is.
