(New York) Several months ago, we met a woman named Kezier at a brunch party we hosted. She was very quiet and sat in a corner just watching. Turns out her mom had dragged her there at the invitation of her aunt and she wasn't really interested in church – just the *free waffles*. We had a good conversation, and she left with a smile. A few days later, some of the team and I were handing out coffee on the sidewalk – something we do often to meet new people and serve our neighborhood. Kezier walked around the corner and almost immediately burst into tears. "As soon as I saw you guys, God said, 'These people are here for you,'" she said.

We chatted for a while about her very difficult week, and I said the church could help out a little. Before the end of the conversation, she had trusted Jesus, and we set up a time to talk about baptism. She was baptized January 3 and is active on our core team planting a new church! I am a church planter in Queens, New York City. In 2011, my wife, Lindsey and I moved here to plant churches and start our family. Now we have four children and have planted one church. We are launching our second this year. We minister to people in western Queens. More than half of our neighborhood is foreign born, so our area is very diverse ethnically as well as religiously. There are more than 20 mosques and just 12 gospel-centered churches for the 750,000 people who live in the four neighborhoods that make up this community. Pray for this new church, Queens Church. Pray that God will use it to transform the Woodside neighborhood for His glory by transforming more people like Kezier.

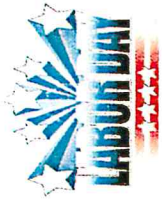
