### Falling in Love with Jesus in South Asia

Zoya's\* family life was a mess. She had fallen in love with a Hindu man, and consequently, her Muslim family disowned her. As the years went by, she became the mother of two and a dutiful Hindu. But her marriage suffered when her husband, Azad\*, began drinking too much.

A friend brought Zoya to the home of Alexander and Lillian Traverston\*, where Zoya found a job as a language tutor. As they studied, Lillian shared stories from a children's Bible. And as time went on, Zoya began coming early to read God's Word and pray with Lillian. Slowly, she started falling in love with Jesus.

She wanted to be baptized, and Azad eventually agreed, saying, "I've seen the change in your life." But their daughter, who had come to know Jesus as well, would not be baptized without her father. They kept praying and sharing the gospel with Azad, who began reading the Bible.

Eighteen months after Zoya was baptized, Azad and his daughter were baptized in the ocean on Christmas Day. Through the faithful witness of a national believer, Zoya and Azad's son also became a Christian. The whole family is now a bold witness in their neighborhood.
