## **Pastor Search Committee Update**

The CBC Pastor Search Committee has received 82 surveys (93% members, 7% non-members) with the largest participating age group being 60+ (51%). Thus far, the results reveal the majority of the participants seek a pastor with 5 years or more experience (73%) and a degree from a seminary/divinity school (50%). The data for the Gifts of a Pastor acknowledges the following, listed from Greatest to Least: Preaching, Leadership, Evangelism & Missions, Pastoral Care, Administrative, Counseling & Crisis Ministries, Prayer and Bible Study/Teaching, Community Involvement, and Identifying & Developing Spiritual Gifts. 
