On August 14 we had a day of equipping for our Bible study classes and leaders. Several people commented on the need and the logistics discussed that day in the 9:30 hour and the afternoon training session. However, I have not heard much since. What has changed in your Bible study classes (Sunday School and others) since August 14? We do not attend or hold training sessions to check some boxes on a spiritual checklist.

There is not a job in the corporate world where you enter, complete your orientation training, and never need to attend another training session. There are ongoing updates, safety training, new technology, and other trainings. Most people attend at least one significant training each year for his/her job. Many jobs require x amount of hours of training each year to maintain certifications.

Every one of those jobs deal with the temporary. You and I are engaged with the eternal. How much more than the corporate world should we be eager and hungry for more training, striving to be better equipped at every one of our volunteer positions in God's kingdom work?
