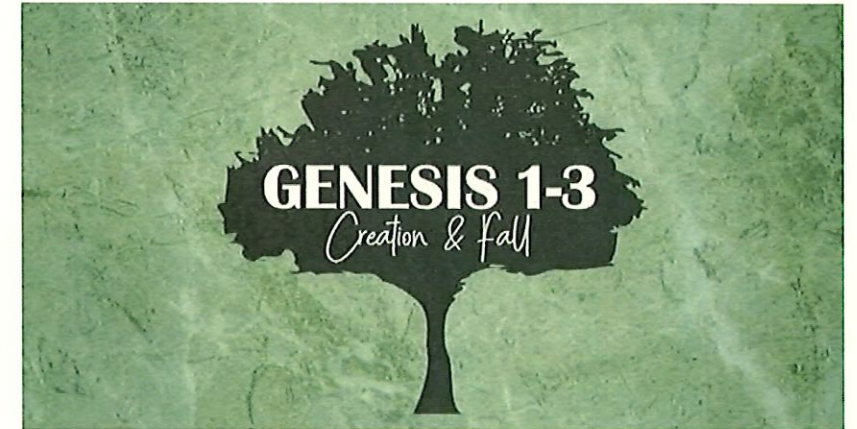
December 5th 5 PM - 8PM
