

Dear Church,

As the old saying goes, "April showers bring May flowers." The implication is that people generally do not like rainy weather (although I do). Most people enjoy sunny days. Those sunny days will come, and colorful flowers with them, but one must endure the rainy season first. The rain is a necessary part of creating those beautiful flowers. So, the saying communicates the necessity of enduring one to get to the other. (Cont'd)

Likewise, we must endure the valleys to reach the mountain. Every mountain that I've ever seen has a valley down below. Metaphorically, the mountain speaks of the place of blessing, while the valley speaks of the place of trial and difficulty. Unless you're dropped from a helicopter, you cannot reach the mountain without first going through the valley.

The valley can be a lonely and cold place. But there's also comfort in the valley. Without the valley, we wouldn't truly understand the faithfulness of God. How could we? But we see that the Lord's faithfulness does not wane in the valley, on the contrary, His faithfulness is magnified. That is what David discovered. He spoke of his own season in the valley in Psalm 23:4, where he stated "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me..."

Perhaps you're currently walking through a valley in your own life. The shadows are long and casting their coldness over you. You wonder when you'll make it to the mountain. Don't give up. Just as the Lord was with David, so too will He be with you. You'll make it to the mountain, and you'll make it at just the right time. God's time. So, don't lose heart in the middle of April's showers, because just around the corner are May's flowers.

WMU met on April 17. We signed cards to be sent to Kentucky Baptist volunteer Missionaries who have birthdays in May.


The list for the Christmas Backpacks was completed, and the date for Christmas in August to collect items for them it is our goal to send 20 backpacks, there will be more information later.
