Trunk or Treat

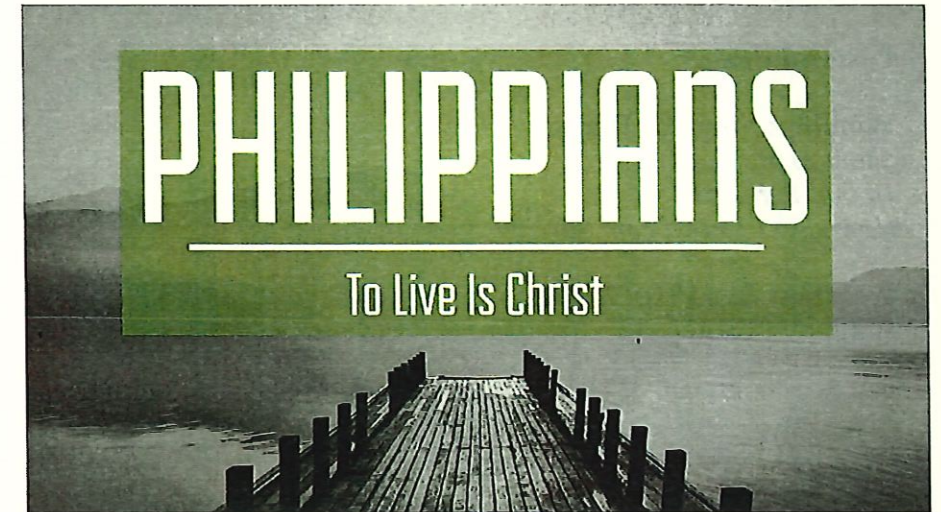
All Types of candy are needed for this event on October 26th. Please place donations in the tote at the Registration Center.
