Fund Raiser Lunch for Guatemala

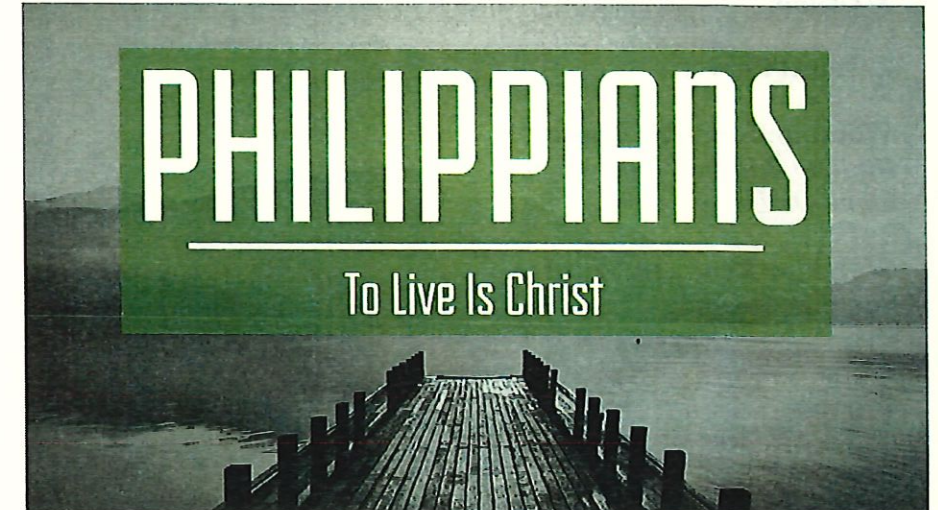
