We will be going to Boone Tavern in Berea on Tuesday November 11. Please sign up at the registration center. Van will leave promptly at 10:15 AM.




Hello church family,

We will study God's Word and learn our Christmas music. Ages 4/5 to 5th grade. Meeting at 6:00 PM.


Bible Drill
